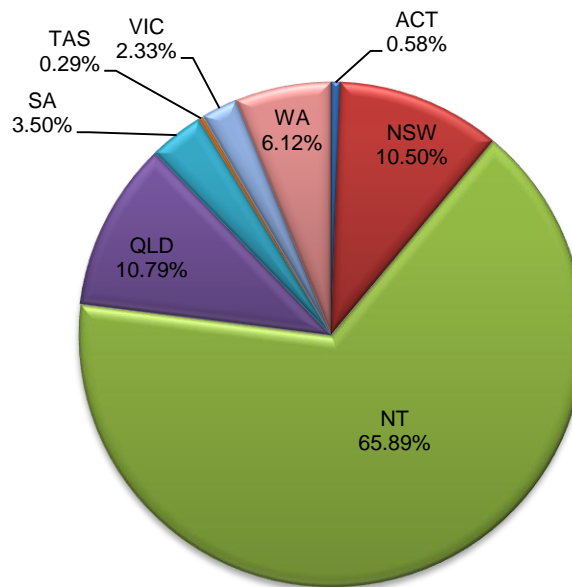


Chart 1: ATSI health practitioners – percentage by principal place of practice

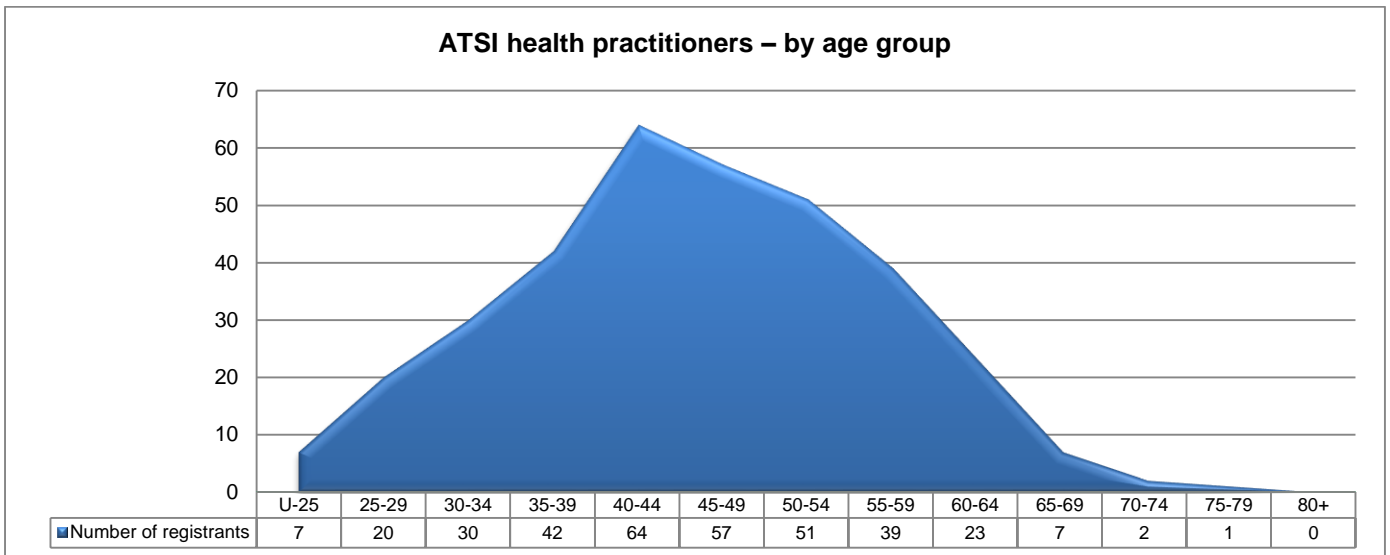


Chart 2: ATSI health practitioners – by age group
