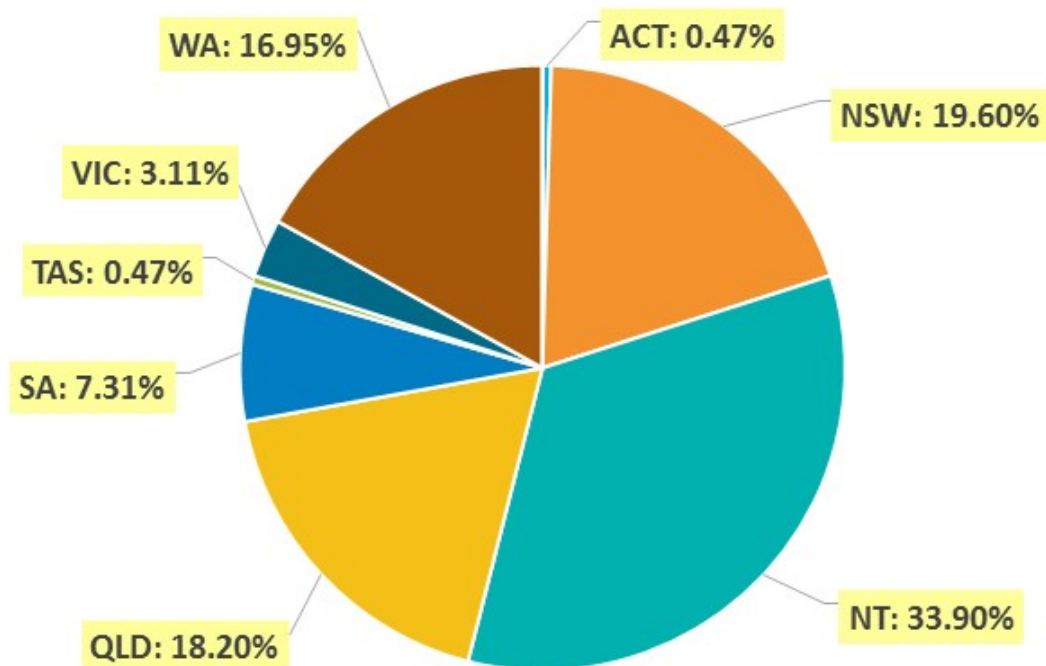

Table 2.1 Percentage by principal place of practice



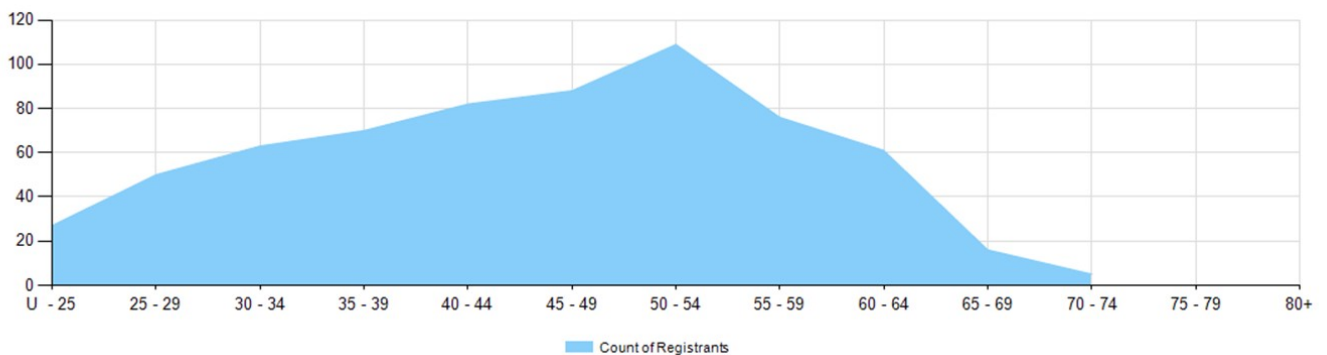
